<b>Personally Owned Vehicles On-Scene</b>	<b>Page 1 of 1</b>	

**PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this standard operating guideline is to define the presence of personally owned vehicles on incident scenes.

**COMMENTARY:**

Most incidents tend to be busy and congested with firefighters and equipment attempting to enter and exit the scene. Because of this, it is of up most importance that we keep personally owned vehicles to the bare minimum on these scenes.

**PROCEDURES:**

No personally owned vehicles will be allowed on any scene unless approved by the Incident Commander.

If approved by the Incident Commander, personally owned vehicles will be parked far enough from the scene as to not interfere with any current or future operations.

At any time during the incident a personally owned vehicle may have to be moved in order to continue operations.
