PURPOSE:

The purpose of this standard operating guideline is to define the roll out order for fire trucks responding to an emergency call.

COMMENTARY:

Firefighters responding to a call with the proper equipment is a must in order to provide the best service we can to our patrons.

Medical call, in this guideline, will be defined as scenes containing patients in need of emergency medical care. These calls will not involve fires or motor vehicle accidents.

Motor vehicle accidents, in this guideline, will be defined as scenes involving one or more motor vehicles. A motor vehicle, in this guideline, will be defined as any vehicle that is ridden or driven and is self propelled. This scene may also include medical patients and vehicle fires.

A structure fire, in the guideline, will be defined as scenes involving any type of building on fire. This scene may contain medical patients and vehicle fires.

Grass fires, in this guideline, will be defined as scenes involving the burning of anything except structures and vehicles.

Mutual Aid, in this guideline, will be defined as any outside agencies that requests the aid of our fire department for any reason.

Storm Spotting, in this guideline, will be defined as the activation of the fire department by either EOC or the Chief for the purpose of observing severe weather.

PROCEDURES:

The roll out order for all emergency calls will be as follows:

Medical Calls:

Rescue
Pumper

All remaining trucks will be staged at the fire station and await instructions from the Incident Commander.

Motor Vehicle Accidents:

Rescue
Pumper

Big Jeep

All remaining trucks will be staged at the fire station and await instructions from the Incident Commander.

Structure Fires:

Pumper

All remaining trucks will be staged at the fire station and await instructions from the Incident Commander.

Mutual Aid:

The requesting agency will determine what trucks they need.

Weather Spotting:

The Rescue and Pumper will roll out to their predetermined locations unless directed otherwise by EOC or the officer in charge.

The Rescue will stage on 400 highway at the 169 Junction.

The Pumper will stage on the east side of the Big Hill Lake dam.

All remaining trucks will be staged at the fire station and await instructions from EOC or the officer in charge.
